- Come prepared with you child's medical history and all immunizations records.

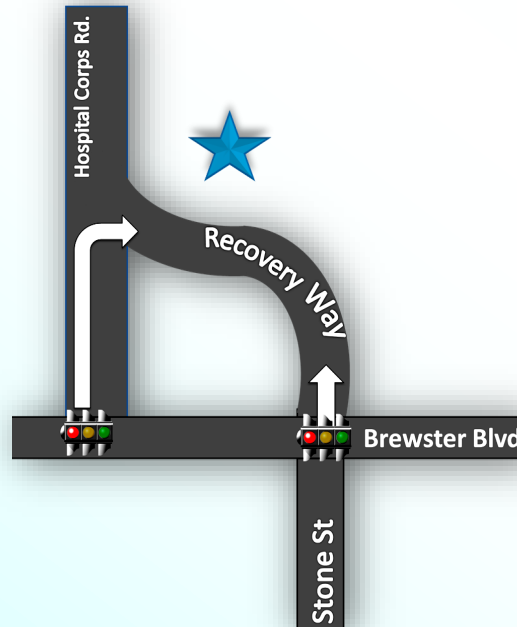


- Bringing a list and contact information from previous outside providers so we can help you create a complete, up-to-date medical record for your child.

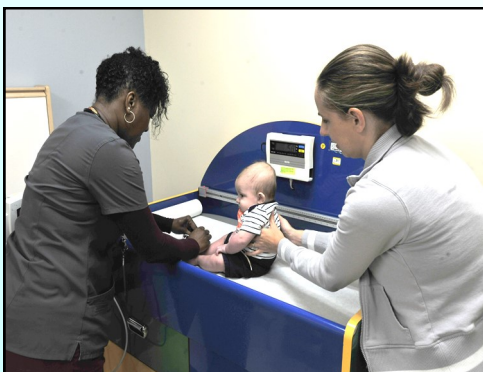

- Access the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal at this website:

- If you do not have a common access card (CAC) or MyPay account, you will need to create a free DS Logon to access the Patient Portal.
- With the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal you can:
 - Manage primary care medical and dental appointments.
 - Review clinical notes, referrals, lab and test results.
 - Exchange secure messages with your health care team.
 - Monitor health information and view your portal profile.
 - Complete a pre-visit, dental health history questionnaire online.
 - Look up high-quality, provider approved health information related to health issues, lab results, and medications.
